2024 PROGRAM GUIDELINES

- Only online applications will be accepted and can be submitted after January 1, 2024 by visiting: www.titan-intl.com/antique-tractor-restoration
- Every application must have approval and sponsorship from the chapter representative. Please complete the application in its entirety, including a "before" picture of the tractor that will be restored.
- Incomplete applications will not be accepted and does not guarantee tire availability until a complete application is submitted and accepted.
- Tires requested will be no wider than 18.4 section width and no larger than 38" bead.
- Tractors must be 1970 or older and 2WD. No MFWD or 4WD will be accepted. Tractors must also be owned by the student or the chapter (no third-party tractors).
- The Titan Customer Service team will provide acceptance notifications and tire order numbers via email to the applicants. They will then provide a notification when the tires are scheduled for delivery to the closest Titan Dealer. The FFA chapter sponsor or project champion is responsible for picking up the tires at the dealership.

- Each FFA chapter/4-H group with approved applications will receive tires for no more than two tractor restorations (four tires/tractor) per calendar year; one tractor/set per student, per lifetime. Any student with a previously approved tractor restoration project is not eligible for the Titan antique tractor restoration program.
- A submitted picture of the restored tractor is required within a year of accepted application date or an invoice will be sent to the chapter/group for the provided tires.
- Chapters/groups that are found to have violated guidelines will be placed on a 5-year probation of the program.
- Program will be active while allocated supplies last; applications will be reviewed and accepted on a first come, first served basis.
- Tires for approved projects will be shipped to the student's high school unless other arrangements are made by the student/advisor.
